It is the fourth oldest operating theater on the same site in the United States and is considered the best-preserved German-American theater in the country. **The Pabst Mansion**, on the National Registry of Historic Homes, is 20,000 square feet of elaborately handcrafted woodwork, original wall coverings and furnishings, leaded glass, and important 19th century art work. Next, we will enjoy a guided tour of Milwaukee's living museum, the **Boerner Botanical Gardens**. The setting of these gardens is reminiscent of an English Country Manor with glacial fieldstone walls and historic, limestone statuary. The tour will be followed with **lunch in the gardens**. The last stop of the day will be **Trimborn Farm Park** where you will take a giant step back into pioneer times. Reminisce about 19th century farm life, and witness Wisconsin culture come to life as embodied by the immigrant entrepreneur Werner Trimborn, his family and his employees. *Overnight Milwaukee, WI; Breakfast & lunch included*

Friday, August 14, 2009
