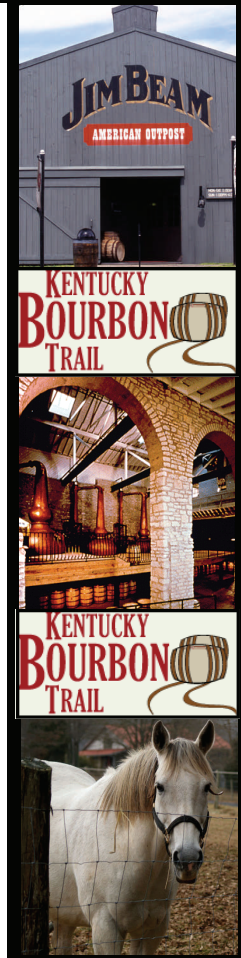

Meals: Appetizer Buffet

Travel with us to **Bardstown, KY** to the **Jim Beam Distillery**. Start your visit at the American Outpost by experiencing "America's First Family of Bourbon," a **film** about the Beams' family history and their bourbon making process. Walk the **Exhibit Hall** and see how they make bourbon. And check out the 200-year timeline showcasing some heirloom bottles of Beam before anyone called it "Beam." They've also got one of the oldest moonshine stills in America, and a cooperage exhibit. Finally, you'll visit a **rack house** and see first-hand how the bourbon is gently aged. Our next stop will be the **Heaven Hill Heritage Center**. We will view a **film** on the history of Bourbon, take a **behind the scenes tour** of a Bourbon-aging rack house and taste two of **Heaven Hill Distilleries** premium brands.

Enjoy free time in **downtown Bardstown** for lunch and shopping on your own before heading to our next destination, the **Oscar Getz Museum of Whiskey History**. We'll wrap up our day in Bardstown with a visit to the **Chapeze House** and a special **Bourbon Tasting** hosted by **Colonel Michael Masters**. This will be an absolutely unforgettable



Kentucky experience as you enjoy the ambience of the **Chapeze House**, a great & historic Kentucky Federal Mansion. You'll have the opportunity to **sample premium Kentucky Bourbon brands** from a wide variety of distilleries and enjoy **savory appetizers**.

A short drive will bring us to **Lexington, Kentucky** where we will overnight in style at the **Hilton Suites Lexington Green**. The evening is at your leisure to take advantage of nearby dining, shopping and entertainment.

Sunday, May 24, 2009

Meals: Breakfast

We will start our day at the **Kentucky Horse Park**. The park is home to some 115 horses representing approximately 50 different breeds. There are a number of opportunities where visitors will be invited by handlers to pet the horses throughout the day. There are also many activities to enjoy daily. For example, **International Museum of the Horse**, **American Saddlebred Museum**, and film, **Thou Shalt Fly Without Wings** and many more.

Our next stop will capture your heart and make you look at horses in a whole new light. **Old Friends** began as a retirement and rescue facility for pensioned Thoroughbreds. Then news broke of the inconceivable death of Kentucky Derby winner Ferdinand in a slaughterhouse in Japan in 2002. Knowing such a death must never happen again, the plan became to bring "at risk" racehorses--those whose racing and breeding careers had come to an end--to **Old Friends**, provide them with the dignified retirement they deserve, and open the space to the public. Since then **Old Friends** has retired two mares (including Bonnie's Poker, the dam of 1997 Derby winner Silver Charm) and five geldings (including **Seabiscuit star Popcorn Deelites**).

We'll wrap up our tour with a visit to the gorgeous **Woodford Reserve Distillery!** After a guided tour of the distillery, we will have the chance to sample the reserve's award winning bourbon & munch on bourbon balls.
